Etruscan and Roman Empires with special reference to Pompeii; Impact of religion on sexuality (Codex, written and unwritten laws, permissible and prohibited), Far Eastern understanding of sexuality, Specifics of Orthodox Christianity, Sexuality of people with disabilities; We, other Victorians - modern western civilization is founded on the Greek Roman tradition and the Christian religion, Sexuality and body; Some of impressive examples of sexual relations in the world literature, Sexuality through the history of dance; Psychology and psychopathology of human sexuality, Erectile dysfunction - epidemiology, diagnosis and therapy -Surgical aspects; Sexually transmitted diseases, human immunodeficiency virus; Impact of STD on pregnancy, Impact of STD on newborns; Erectile dysfunction - epidemiology, diagnosis and therapy - Internist aspects; Artificial abortion: history, medical indications, regulations, techniques, potential consequences. Family planning. Hormonal contraception; Hormonal activity at different ages: puberty, reproductive period, climacterium and menopause; Far East: Indochina and Japan; History of Parfumes.
